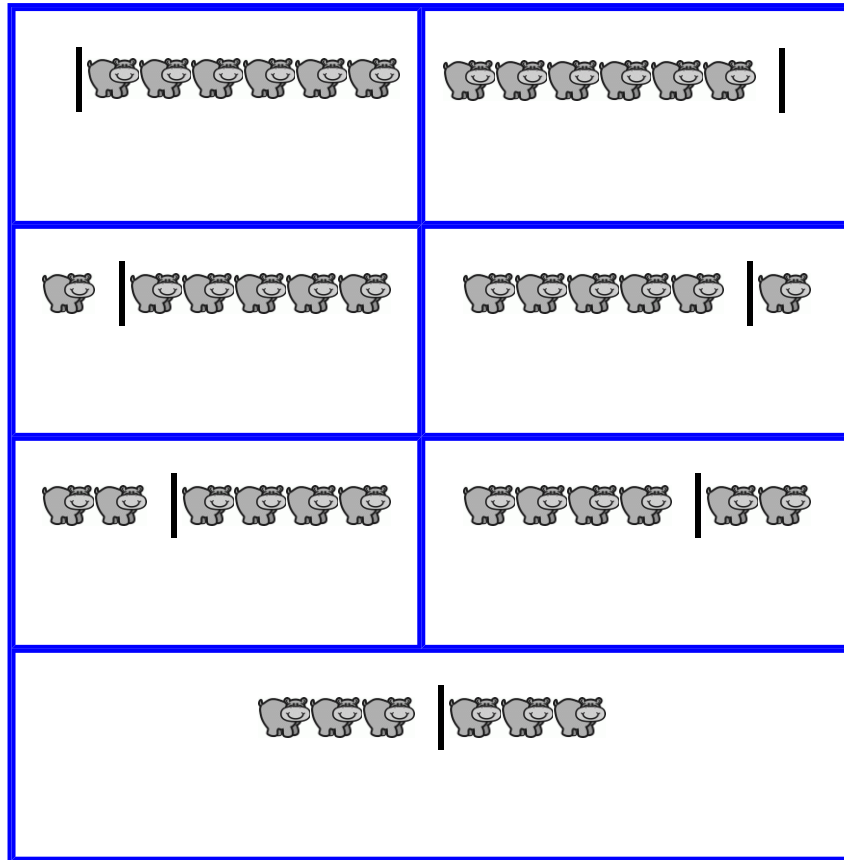


Sums with 6
