

Similar Figures


1. Are the following figures congruent, similar, or neither?



- 2. When you follow these instructions, is the resulting triangle similar to the original, congruent, or neither?
 - a. You draw a copy of this triangle, but while drawing, your paper is upside down.
 - **b.** You draw a new triangle using the same angle measurements as in this triangle but different side lengths.
 - **c.** You draw a new triangle using one same angle measurement as in this triangle but the other two angles are not the same.
 - **d.** You draw a new triangle so that its sides are exactly twice as long as the sides in the original triangle.
- 3. Draw a larger copy of this quadrilateral. Let each side be exactly 1.5 as long as the sides in the original. Your copy will be (similar/congruent) to the original one.



4. Draw a smaller copy of this parallelogram. Let each side be exactly 0.7 as long as the sides in the original. Your copy will be (similar/congruent) to the original one.
