The little comma separates millions places (digits) from the rest.

**5,000,000**

Read: 5 million

**69,000,000**

Read: 69 million

**967,000,000**

Read: 976 million

The whole millions above all have 6 zeros!

After the millions, the rest of the number is read just like you have learned before.

**347,500,000**

347 million 500 thousand

**19,020,000**

19 million 20 thousand

**347,040,326**

347 million 40 thousand 326

Simply read the word "million" at the first comma, and "thousand" at the second comma.
