

Fact Families

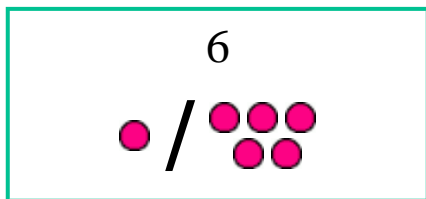
Two addition facts and two subtraction facts form a fact family if they use the same three numbers.

For example, with 5, 3, and 2 we get a fact family:

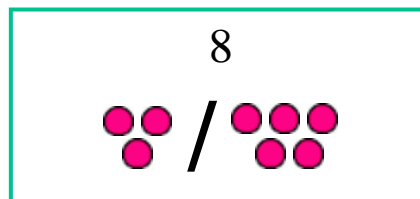
$$2 + 3 = 5 \quad 5 - 3 = 2$$

$$3 + 2 = 5 \quad 5 - 2 = 3$$

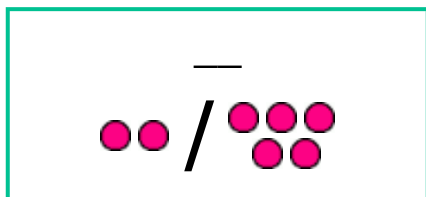
