





# Subtraction is 'Taking Away'

From five bananas we take away three.      There are two left.


$$5 - 3 = 2$$







Five minus three equals two

From six carrots we take away one.      There are five left.


$$6 - 1 = 5$$

Six minus one equals five

<p>8 in total, cross out 7.</p>  $8 - 7 =$	<p>8 in total, cross out 6.</p>  $8 - 6 =$	<p>7 in total, cross out 3.</p>  $7 - 3 =$
