Practicing with Money

• One quarter = cents. Use ONE quarter when the money amount is between 25 and 50 cents. Example: To make 31 cents, take one quarter, one nickel, and one penny.
• Two quarters = cents. Use TWO quarters when the money amount is between 50 and 75 cents. Example: To make 62 cents, take two quarters, one dime, and two pennies.
• Three quarters = cents. Use THREE quarters when the money amount is between 75 and 100 cents. Example: To make 87 cents, use three quarters, one dime, and two pennies.
• Four quarters = 100 cents or one dollar.
