 \$1 or \$1.00	This is one dollar (loonie). It is worth 100 cents.	 = \$3.00
 \$2 or \$2.00	This is two dollars (toonie). It is worth 200 cents.	 = \$1.20
 \$5 or \$5.00	This is a five-dollar bill. It is worth 500 cents.	 = \$5.25
